




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WELCOME FROM TEAM LVC

Jacquart Events LLC (Producer), Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor), Disc Golf Pro Tour (Media Sponsor), Wildhorse Golf Course (Host), and Team Las Vegas Challenge (Volunteers), in partnership with the many other sponsors (see pages **48**, **50**, & **52** for details) are honored to present the 23rd Annual Las Vegas Challenge (LVC) disc golf tournament! The MPO & FPO divisions will be participating in the PDGA Elite Series DGPT Pro Tour, with this being the second year the LVC is an Elite Event, while the aged-restricted professional divisions and amateur divisions are participating in a PDGA A-Tier Event.

The 2022 format will mimic that used since 2016 (the year the LVC was moved form Sunset Park), with each of the ≈570 participants playing all three temporary courses at least once, and only the top 40% of each division playing a fourth round in the Sunday finals. Should the LVC return to the DGPT Elite Series in 2023, it is anticipated that participants will only be playing two of the three courses, and possibly having the amateur divisions playing the prior weekend...so there may be a significant change in the venue next year.

The 135-acre Wildhorse property offers ample room for three premier course designs (each with their own "flare"); a large warm up area; a grand vendor tent; an indoor media, check-in, and VIP center; ample room for a player warm-up area; and a spectator arena (which also hosts the Saturday night Player's Party). Pages 1 & 2 provided a detailed map of Tournament Central and page 10 highlights each Vendor Booth. The Schedule of Events are listed on pages 20, 22 & 24, Contests & Fun Activities listed on pages 28 & 30, and an Overall Map is provided on pages 55 & 56.

WELCOME FROM THE SPONSORS

As detailed on pages **48**, **50**, & **52**, over \$300,000 has been donated by almost 90 individual sponsors. A majority (43%) is in goods, about a quarter (26%) is in actual cash, 10% is in media, 6% in partnered sales, 6% in cost savings, 4% in items borrowed (like baskets), 2% in staff, 1% in credit, and 1% in supplies, and the remainder in other services.

Our Title sponsor, Innova Champion Discs, makes up 42% of all the sponsorship value. Our Course sponsors, Factory Store and Infinite Discs, makes up 17% of the total value. The producer of the LVC, Jacquart Events LLC, totals 7% of the total value. Our Tournament Partner sponsors makes up 12%, our Jackpot sponsors makes up 10%, our Vendors makes up 5%, our Grand and Mini Event sponsors each make up 3%, our Ring of Fire and Flag sponsors make up less than 1%.

Almost 40 vendors will be selling at some time during the LVC. With the LVC being an Innova-centric event, only during the Saturday Fly Mart will you find competing manufacturer products.

The 2022 schedule is similar to the 2021 version. "This process is always challenging, and we prioritized sustainability and simplicity for 2022 as much of our focus went to securing our partnership and merging the tours successfully with the PDGA," said Jeff Spring, DGPT CEO & Director. "One focus was working backward to Emporia to allow ease of travel to the PDGA Pro Worlds, which has been scheduled on that date for over 10 months. We wanted to make it easy for players to get there."

Former National Tour Events, The Master's Cup, and the Beaver State Fling are set to be on the Silver Series schedule while discussions continue to include the Music City Open. The Delaware Disc Golf Challenge will not be a DGPT event in 2022 as they look to take a year off from elite competition.

A new addition to the DGPT schedule is a playoff format for the final two events, the Green Mountain Championship, and the MVP Open at Maple Hill. While final details will be announced, these events will stay normal stroke play events but see the field sizes reduced as the Tour blazes a path to the DGPT Championship. "I expect the men's field to be cut down to around 100 for the GMC and 80 when we get to Maple Hill, and the women's field to go from 50 to 40." Said Spring. "This will set the stage for a dramatic weekend in Leicester, MA to determine not only DGPT Points Champions, but the players who will qualify for the Tour Championship."

WELCOME FROM WILDHORSE


Once again, the Wildhorse Golf Course, established in 1958, the only municipal golf course owned by the City of Henderson, is proud to host the 23rd Annual Las Vegas Challenge disc golf tournament. After the success of last six events, improvements continue to be made to the two quasi-permanent disc golf courses on our property via Team LVC. If you didn't know, disc golf play is available year-round at Wildhorse!

Our 24-hole afternoon course, which incorporates four of the **Course Innova Factory Store** holes and most of the **Course Innova** holes, is available for play in the afternoon. Our 22-hole morning course, with tee times available from sunrise to half-an-hour after sunrise, incorporates many **Course Innova Factory Store** holes and **Course Infinite Discs** holes. 

PLAYER EXPERIENCE

Although most of the media attention is focused on the DGPT Elite Series divisions...as it should be since the Open divisions represent the top men and women players of our sport...we want ALL players of the LVC to feel like our event is like no other. We are lucky that the Wildhorse facility has enough acreage to accommodate three premier courses, which allows three different pools to participate in the LVC at the same time. This is why we ask that all sponsor and partner assets remain in place throughout the entire event so each player can get a sense of what the tour card holders are treated to throughout the year. This is why we host combined pool-player parties so everyone can appreciate the vibe and excitement that happens at top major events. This is why all players can have a caddy so their best friend, parent, sibling, or fan can also experience what it kind of means to be an "elite." In turn, we hope each player and their caddy respects each other, the volunteers, the vendors, and media representatives so a sense of professionalism is felt throughout the LVC.

We peaked our player allowances at the LVC back in 2017 (around 570 players). We just can't accommodate any more participants without using additional courses, and everyone wants to play Wildhorse. So, the only way additional players can be added to the LVC/Wildhorse experience is to add another weekend to the event...which is likely going to happen in 2023. The precursor to the LVC, the Gentlemen's Club Challenge (GCC), was also hosted over two weekends when the event was hosted at Sunset Park and we outgrew the typical one-weekend format after 2009. Pamela Madrid, our Lead Volunteer Coordinator, said is best that if we stay stagnant and refuse to accept change, then eventually the event becomes just like all others...not as memorable as we want it to be!







SPECTATOR EXPERIENCE

Starting last year, all DGPT Elite Series events required the purchase of a spectator pass.

After participating in The Challenge at Goat Hill Park hosted in Oceanside, CA - another disc golf event held on a ball golf course - we learned how the cart paths were natural assets for spectator viewing and provided ample room for thousands to enjoy almost every throw. The last two pages of this caddy book includes a large map of where spectators are permitted, unless directed otherwise by tournament staff.



Cart Paths - The cart path is defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the concrete edge of the cart path (including raised edging) meet, unless marked by rope. All other improvements (see examples below) adjacent to the cart path are not part of the cart path. The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on dirt or grass growing over a cart path edge is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)













Casual Water - Unless marked as O.B., play casual water as a Casual Area (806.03). Lie may be relocated to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief, without penalty.



Course Availability - Courses are closed after Wednesday. Players caught playing a closed course are in violation of Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Facility main gate is locked from sundown to sunrise.

Discs Retrieval (from Back Yards & Water Areas) - Entering into private yards or wading into water to retrieve a disc will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director and potential criminal/trespassing charges by the City of Henderson Police Department.

Dress Code (applies to All Divisions) - All players are expected to dress appropriately and to maintain a clean and well-groomed appearance at all event sites and associated functions. All players must wear shoes and a well-tailored shirt with a collar and sleeves covering upper chest area and upper arm. Crew neck or v-neck shirts made of high-performance or high-tech materials are permitted. Shirts that hang down lower than the bottom hemline on the player's shorts shall be tucked in. Women may wear sleeveless shirts with collars or a well-tailored one-piece tennis dress. (Also see Competition Manual, 3.04(D).)

Island Holes - Disc must <u>come to rest</u> on marked islands (Course Innova, Holes 3, 6, and 7, and Course Infinite Discs, Holes 6 and 18). If island missed, <u>as approved by the PDGA</u>, take one-stroke penalty and next shot from the designated drop zone(s).

Media Rights - Jacquart Events LLC (Producer), Innova Champion Discs (Title Sponsor), Disc Golf Pro Tour (Media Sponsor) and event partners owns all media rights to the LVC. The sand trap is defined as the point where the roots of the grass and the sand meet (unless marked by rope, then rope). The hazard line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The hazard line is part of the hazard area. (A disc landing on grass growing over a sand trap is in the hazard when 100% of the disc is on the hazard-side of the vertical plane.)



Selling of Merchandise - Permission is <u>not</u> granted to sell merchandise on Wildhorse property without consent of the Tournament Director. Such activities will be seen as Player Misconduct and subject to immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Smoking Areas - There are designated smoking areas for the facility (parking lot and outside balconies) and on each course and within the practice area (within 30 feet of a restroom). Pace of play rules still apply. Any open and visual possession of any product banned under the smoking policy will be treated as a courtesy violation, and violators will be asked to put away the product until after the round has concluded.

Teeing Areas - The teeing area is defined by the area bounded by the edges of the provided tee pad (the artificial turf). When in use, Teeing Areas are in-bounds.

Two Meter Rule - Not in effect for all courses, all holes.

Water Areas - Water areas are defined as the point where the water and the roots of the grass meet (unless marked by rope). The out-of-bounds line is a vertical up-and-down plane. The out-of-bounds line is part of the out-of-bounds area. (A disc landing on grass growing over water is out-of-bounds when 100% of the disc is on the O.B.-side of the vertical plane.)

Zero Tolerance - Any inappropriate activities will be dealt with immediately.

Wildhorse has been reserved for a private function. Public access is not guaranteed. All spectators shall behave appropriately. Unless otherwise provided, spectators may not play on any LVC courses. The 9-hole mini course and other extra-curricular activities may be played by all attendees.

All spectators, competitors, and approved media shall abide by the following:

- Cell phones must remain silent at all times while on the facility.
- Do not approach competitors within 30 minutes of their tee time nor at any point during their round. This applies to Starter's Tent area, transition between holes, and while waiting to tee or play.
- Remain at least 20 meters (66 feet) from competitors, all DISCatcher targets in play, and the greens.
- Make every effort to maintain positions on the course that do not interfere with competitors or tournament play. Competitors and/or LVC staff may request you to reposition at their discretion.
- Remain completely still when in close proximity to any competitor who is in the process of lining up or executing a throw.
- Avoid being in direct sightline of players. This may sometimes be unavoidable, particularly around the putting area. Competitors and/or LVC staff may ask you to move.
- Make every effort not to block a shot already set by a member of the media.
 Approved Media: Both still and video media share priority and are expected to demonstrate professional courtesy.
- Approved Media: Position yourself so that camera shutters cannot be heard by competitors during the throwing motion, or begin shooting once the disc has left the competitor's hand.
- Violations of any of these rules are grounds for immediate removal from the facility.
